






## How to use **Blue** and **Yellow** sticky traps

**Uses :** It is used in the field to attract insect pest by their colour. Insects stick on the sticky traps.

### Procedure

-  Hang the sticky traps with the help of bamboo pole, at crop canopy level uniformly across the field.
-  Place the sticky traps 1-5 days after transplanting.
-  It can also be used in the Nursery
-  Replace the sticky traps with new ones after every 3-4 weeks
-  The number of sticky traps required is 60 per hectare. That is 30 yellow and 30 blue sticky







## Yellow and Blue Sticky traps control and monitor:





**Blue traps against**  
- Thrips  
- Leaf miners



**Yellow traps against**  
- Aphids, black aphids  
- Whitefly

## DO IT YOURSELF (DIY)

### Materials required:

Hard board or card board  
Yellow and blue paints  
Grease or glue

### Methodology

Cut the card board into small rectangular sizes

First paint the card board with yellow or blue paints and dry it, then apply the grease on the painted board.

Hang it in the field with bamboo pole.
